
In an age in which an individual's right to choose their own health care is seemingly under constant attack, it is crucial that Congress continue exploring ways to further build a strong free-market health care system and improve access to affordable care through various private sector options.

My bill, the Health Freedom for Seniors Act (H.R. 3819), is a simple step in that direction by allowing seniors currently forced to take Required Minimum Distributions from their retirement accounts (IRAs, 401(k)s, etc.) to instead roll that amount tax-free into an existing Health Savings Account.

H.R. 3819 is just one of several legislative proposals on how to expand the use of HSAs and increase an individual's power over their own health care decisions. I urge you to support my proposal, as well as others that promote the great cause of freedom to choose one's own health care.
